More Than Words

As I stepped up to the pulpit on Sunday to preach, I looked up at the four beautiful banners hanging high on the back wall of the sanctuary. I'm sure it's easy to be in the sanctuary and not see them, but they are very obvious if you are facing the congregation. I've spotted them on our website, as well.

They must be important!

Here they are: WELCOME, GROW, SERVE, CELEBRATE.

Each word evokes an image: A father leans forward on the porch and strains to see his returning son, covered in pig mud, on the horizon. He doesn't wait for his son to come to him; he runs out in the pasture and embraces him (**WELCOME**). Jesus teaches that the kingdom of God is like that of a mustard seed--one of the smallest seeds there is-- but which grows into a bush so big that it turns into a hotel for birds (**GROW**). Jesus, just before being crucified, treats his disciples to a dinner they'll never forget. The master takes a towel and washes his disciples' feet, thus re-defining what's most important in God's Kingdom (**SERVE**). A woman loses a coin in her house. She rips up the linoleum until she finds her precious coin, and when she finds it, she is so ecstatic that she throws a wild block party with her neighbors (**CELEBRATE**). So what are we to do with these words?

Let's make them more than words on banners!

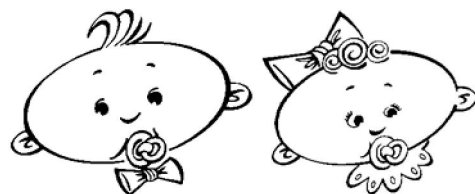
